The Heritage of the Perfect Sports Car

"The philosophy of the company is as unique as its cars. Every model that bears the Porsche crest on the hood must combine sporting performance with everyday usability. It's this intelligent combination of design, performance and efficiency that makes Porsche cars so special."

As manager of the Historical Archives of Porsche AG with the responsibility for the heritage of the Porsche brand, Dieter Landenberger, is perfectly placed to tell us about Porsche's design DNA and the key role the 911 model has played in the company's goal of creating the perfect sports car.

"For more than half a century the Porsche 911 has been revered as an iconic automobile and the very epitome of the sports car. The 911 has consistently gone its own way, not only in terms of design, but also with regard to technology. The timeless design of the 911 series is undoubtedly a vital element of that legacy; it blends emotion with functionality."

"The Porsche designers responsible for the seven 911 generations so far have been consistently indifferent to passing fads. On the contrary, the design has been continuously evolved taking great care to preserve its unique identity. 'Form follows function' has been a natural guiding principle throughout."

Das Erbe des perfekten Sportwagens

„Die Philosophie des Unternehmens ist genauso einzigartig wie seine Autos. Jedes Modell, das das Porsche Wappen auf der Haube trägt, muss sportliche Leistung mit Alltagstauglichkeit vereinen. Als Leiter des Historischen Archivs der Porsche AG und mitverantwortlich für das Erbe der Marke Porsche ist Dieter Landenberger der ideale Ansprechpartner, um uns die Design-DNA von Porsche zu erläutern. Und uns die tragende Rolle des 911 bei der Verwirklichung des Unternehmensziels, einen perfekten Sportwagen zu bauen, zu erklären.

„Seit über einem halben Jahrhundert wird der Porsche 911 als legendäres Automobil verehrt und gilt als der Sportwagen überhaupt. Der 911 ist konsequent eigene Wege gegangen, nicht nur, was das Design betrifft, sondern auch bezüglich der Technologie. Das zeitlose Design der 911 Modellreihe ist ohne Frage ein entscheidendes Element dieses Erbes; hier verbinden sich Emotion und Funktionalität.“

„Die Porsche Konstrukteure, die für die sieben Generationen des 911 zuständig waren, zeigten sich konsequent unbeeindruckt von Modeerscheinungen. Vielmehr wurde das Design fortlaufend weiterentwickelt und sorgsam darauf geachtet, die einzigartige Identität des Autos zu bewahren. Dem Design-Leitsatz ‚form follows function‘ wurde mit großer Selbstverständlichkeit Rechnung getragen.“

➤ "In the course of the last fifty years our engineers have regularly reinvented the 911. With innovations such as the three-spoke safety steering wheel (1963), Targa roll bar (1965), internally ventilated disk brakes (1966), front and rear spoilers (1972), exhaust gas turbocharger (1974), hot-dip galvanised body shell (1975), intercooler (1977), Digital Motor Electronics (1983), Tiptronic (1989), aluminium chassis (1993), On-Board Diagnosis (1995), ceramic brake disks (2001), dual clutch transmission (2008), or seven-speed manual transmission (2011) – the 911 has repeatedly set new technological benchmarks.

"The 911 has always been committed to the performance principle and motor racing is its most important test lab. From the very beginning, it has been at home on circuits all over the world, earning itself a reputation as a versatile and reliable winning vehicle. It should come as no surprise to learn that a good two-thirds of Porsche's tally of 30,000 race victories to date were notched up by the 911."

"With the new 911 GT3 RS, Porsche continues the heritage of street-legal, high-performance models. For the Porsche brand these models are very important. With their extraordinary performance and sportiness they are pure drivers' cars. The new 911 GT3 RS maintains the basic idea of Ferry Porsche who once said: 'Driving enjoyment is not created by comfort, but quite the opposite.'" ❖

„Im Laufe der vergangenen fünfzig Jahre haben unsere Ingenieure den 911 immer wieder neu erfunden. Mit Innovationen wie dem Dreispeichen-Sicherheitslenkrad (1963), dem Targa Überrollbügel (1965), den innenbelüfteten Scheibenbremsen (1966), dem Front- und Heckspoiler (1972), dem Abgasturbolader (1974), der feuerverzinkten Karosserie (1975), dem Ladeluftkühler (1977), der digitalen Motorelektronik (1983), der Tiptronic (1989), dem Aluminium-Fahrwerk (1993), dem On-Board-Diagnosesystem (1995), den Keramik-Bremsscheiben (2001), dem Doppelkupplungsgetriebe (2008) oder dem Siebengang-Schaltgetriebe (2011) hat der 911 immer wieder neue Maßstäbe in der Fahrzeugtechnik gesetzt.“

„Das Leistungsprinzip war seit jeher ein Fixpunkt, und der Motorsport ist noch heute sein wichtigstes Testlabor. Von Beginn an war der 911 auf den Rennstrecken rund um den Globus zuhause und hat sich seinen Ruf als vielseitiges und zuverlässiges Siegerfahrzeug erworben. Es überrascht daher nicht, dass in der Bilanz aller 30.000 Rennsiege von Porsche gute zwei Drittel auf den 911 entfallen.“

„Mit dem neuen 911 GT3 RS setzt Porsche das Erbe der Hochleistungsmodelle mit Straßenzulassung fort. Für die Marke Porsche sind diese Modelle äußerst wichtig.“

Mit ihrer herausragenden Leistung und Sportlichkeit sind sie reine „drivers' cars“. Der neue 911 GT3 RS wurde ganz nach der Devise von Ferry Porsche konstruiert, der einmal gesagt hat: „Fahrspaß wird nicht durch Komfort erzeugt – das Gegenteil ist der Fall.“ ❖

Designing Perfection

If the address 'Porsche Straße 911' is not enough in itself, the roaring sounds from the nearby test track will soon convince you that the Porsche Development Center at Weissach, close to Stuttgart, is a very special place. This is where all Porsches are designed and tested, and concepts like the Porsche 911 GT3 RS are refined to perfection by the Head of GT Cars, Andreas Preuninger, and his team of designers, engineers and mechanics.

As the leader of the team responsible for the current range of GT cars at Porsche, there is no one better than Mr Preuninger to describe why the latest Porsche 911 GT3 RS is such a special driving experience.

"First of all, the base car we start from – the 911 – is without a doubt the best driver's car in the world. Secondly, we shouldn't forget that we make the car better for the specific needs of our special target group and not necessarily for everybody. The focus is to make the car a true driver's car without having to care about all the compromises a more all-round sports car has to consider."

Design in Perfektion

Wenn die Adresse „Porschestraße 911“ als Hinweis nicht ausreicht, dann sind es die dröhnenden Motoren von der nahegelegenen Teststrecke, die den eindeutigen Beweis dafür liefern, dass das Porsche Entwicklungszentrum in Weissach bei Stuttgart ein ganz besonderer Ort ist. Hier befindet sich neben der Entwicklungs- und Testzentrale für alle Porsche auch der Motorsportbereich. Und genau dort werden Hochleistungssportwagen wie der 911 GT3 RS von GT-Chef Andreas Preuninger und seinem Team aus Konstrukteuren, Ingenieuren und Mechanikern konzipiert.

Andreas Preuninger kann als Leiter des Teams, das für die aktuelle Serie von GT-Straßenfahrzeugen bei Porsche verantwortlich zeichnet, besser als jeder andere erläutern, warum der neueste 911 GT3 RS ein derart besonderes Fahrerlebnis vermittelt.

„Zuerst einmal ist die Basis, auf der wir aufsetzten, der 911, ohne Zweifel das beste „driver's car“ der Welt. Dabei sollten wir nicht vergessen, dass wir das Auto für die besonderen Anforderungen unserer speziellen Zielgruppe optimieren, also nicht unbedingt für jeden Fahrer. Der Schwerpunkt unserer Arbeit liegt darin, den Wagen zu einer echten „Fahrmaschine“ zu machen, ohne Kompromisse eingehen zu müssen, die bei anderen, eher alltagstauglicheren 911 Modellen unumgänglich sind.“

- “The car has to transmit a lot of information to the driver, melt into one with him and give him that seat-of-the-pants feeling; it has to become his prolonged arm. Another important point is the mechanical character of all the technology involved; it's not a bad thing if you feel and hear the valves hissing, gears turning or even whining, that gives the car identity and character... Some edges here and there are welcome in a true motoring car.”

“It's important for us that the car has to be pleasing to the eye, while also looking purposeful and mildly aggressive... But all the components have to function efficiently to make the car perform as well as possible. It's 'form follows function', but only if the form looks cool, if you know what I mean.”

So what did Mr Preuninger think when he saw the final LEGO Technic version of his car? “I was astonished about how much resemblance could be achieved to the real car just using LEGO components. The specific creases in the hood and roof, the openings in the fenders, the big wing and air intakes are all there, so you can see at first glance this is an RS. The way working features such as the paddle-shift PDK gearing system have been integrated into the model is just amazing.”

„Das Auto muss dem Fahrer eine Menge an Informationen übermitteln, mit ihm eins werden, sich passgenau anfühlen – es muss zu seinem verlängerten Arm werden. Ein wichtiger Punkt dabei sind die mechanischen Eigenschaften der eingesetzten Technik. Es ist gar nicht schlecht, wenn man als Fahrer wahrnimmt, wie z.B. die Ventile arbeiten, oder Zahnräder ineinander greifen, denn das verleiht dem Auto Identität und Charakter. Hier und da ein paar „Ecken und Kanten“ sind in einem echten Sportwagen durchaus erwünscht.“

„Natürlich ist es auch wichtig, dass das Auto sehr ästhetisch aussieht, dass es trotz aller Funktionalität bestimmt auftritt und einen gewissen Aufforderungscharakter hat. Aber am Ende geht es darum, dass alle Komponenten effizient zusammenarbeiten und das Fahrzeug so die bestmögliche Performance bieten kann. „Form follows function“ ist also gefragt, solange die Form auch „cool“ rüberkommt, wenn Sie verstehen, was ich meine.“

Und was war Andreas Preuningers Eindruck, als er die endgültige LEGO Technic Version seines Autos sah? „Es hat mich erstaunt, wie viel Ähnlichkeit durch die reine Verwendung von LEGO Teilen mit dem echten Auto erreicht wurde. Die ganz speziellen Falzlinien auf der Motorhaube und dem Dach, die Öffnungen in den Kotflügeln, die großen Flügel und die Lufteinlässe finden sich alle im Modell wieder. Es ist sofort ersichtlich, dass es einen RS darstellt. Und wie realistisch verschiedene Funktionen im Modell integriert sind, ist einfach unglaublich. Bestes Beispiel: das Porsche Doppelkupplungsgetriebe mit Schaltpaddles.“

The Driver's Point of View

It may seem a long way from the karting tracks in his native New Zealand to the professional race circuits of Le Mans and Daytona, but for racing driver Brendon Hartley the goal has always been the same: "I want to win. In everything I do."

As a Porsche Works driver and a member of one of the most successful endurance racing teams competing today, the 26-year-old lives and breathes for anything with four wheels and an engine.

Brendon clearly remembers his first impressions of a car that has often been described as the closest you can get to a race car for the road: "The 911 GT3 RS is the first road car I have driven that gave me goose pimples. I only drove it from Weissach to a hotel down the road, but all my senses were overloaded with joy: the sound, the vibration when the revs got close to the red line, the feeling

Das Fahrerlebnis

Es mag ein langer Weg von den Kartbahnen seiner Heimat Neuseeland zu den Rennstrecken der Profis in Le Mans und Daytona gewesen sein, aber Rennfahrer Brendon Hartley hatte immer nur eins im Sinn: „Ich möchte gewinnen. Bei allem, was ich tue.“

Als Porsche Werksfahrer und Teil eines der erfolgreichsten Motorsport-Teams, das sich heute in Langstreckenrennen unter Beweis stellt, begeistert sich der 26-Jährige für alles, was vier Räder und einen Motor hat.

Brendon Hartley kann sich noch gut an seine ersten Eindrücke von dem Auto erinnern, das allgemein als bestmögliche Straßenversion eines Rennwagens gilt:

„Der 911 GT3 RS ist der erste Sportwagen, bei dem ich beim Fahren Gänsehaut bekommen habe. Ich bin nur von Weissach in den nächsten Ort gefahren, aber mich durchströmte sofort ein Glücksgefühl: der Sound und die Vibrationen, wenn die Nadel des Drehzahlmessers bis kurz vor den roten Bereich hochschnellt, unglaublich.“

of the road through the steering wheel, the low, race-car-like position – it all gave me flash backs of the thrills of being in a race car, yet I could take this down the road for the grocery shopping!"

"The car has more down-force, more mechanical grip from the tyres, more horsepower and more muscle, which means it's hard for anybody not to do a double-take as it passes."

His meeting with the LEGO Technic version of the car was also a positive experience, and one that brought back memories of his childhood: "It's amazing. My brother and I were big LEGO enthusiasts as kids, so when I saw this I immediately thought of all the fun I would have pulling it apart and putting it back together. After the initial delight at the way it looked and the fact that they could really convey the lines of the 911 GT3 RS with standard LEGO Technic parts, I was then impressed to see a fully working gearbox and engine."

"My only question after that was: when can I have one?"

„Das Auto hat einen wahnsinnigen Anpressdruck, mehr mechanischen Grip und noch mehr Leistung. Wenn es vorbeifährt, kann man gar nicht anders, als ihm hinterherzusehen.“

Seine Begegnung mit der LEGO Technic Version des Autos war ebenfalls eine schöne Erfahrung, die Erinnerungen an seine Kindheit weckte: „Es ist erstaunlich. Mein Bruder und ich waren als Kinder große LEGO Fans. Bei diesem Anblick habe ich sofort gedacht, wie viel Spaß wir gehabt hätten, es auseinanderzunehmen und wieder zusammenzubauen. Mir gefällt, wie er aussieht. Die gelungene Linienführung des 911 GT3 RS aus LEGO Technic Standardteilen ist beeindruckend. Aber das voll funktionstfähige Getriebe und der Motor haben mich am meisten beeindruckt.“

„Die einzige Frage, die noch bleibt ist: Wann kann ich so einen haben?“

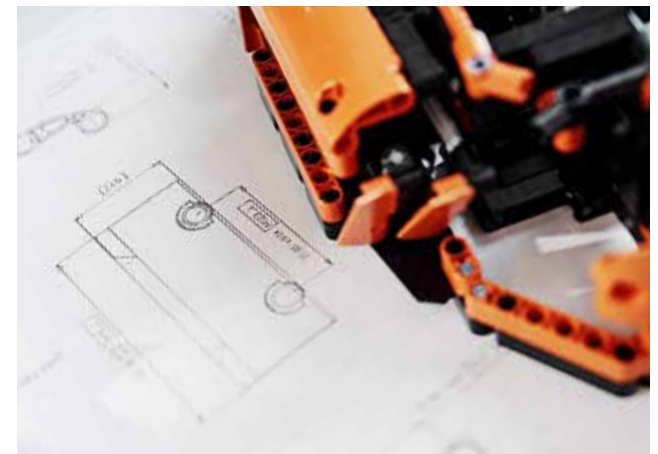
Ein Traumprojekt

„Für mich ist es einfach fantastisch, meine Arbeit und mein Interesse an allem, was mit Design und Leistung von Autos zu tun hat, verbinden zu können. Als wir damit begonnen haben, die Ideen für dieses neue LEGO Technic Konzept zu sammeln, war uns klar, dass wir mehr als nur ein großartiges Bauerlebnis vermitteln wollten. Unser Konzept sollte etwas rundum Besonderes sein, um bei den Fans den Wunsch zu erwecken, das Modell zu besitzen und es zu bauen.“

„Wir wussten, dass wir dafür einen Partner mit dem perfekten Fahrzeug brauchten. Ein Fahrzeug, das Begehrlichkeit weckt und das Zeug zur Legende hat. Also haben wir Kontakt mit Porsche aufgenommen, denn es war unser Traum, den Porsche 911 zu unserem ersten Modell zu machen. → "Based only on images, we started the development of our first model. This was presented to the 911 GT3 RS design team at Porsche, who gave feedback on the important design features that define the iconic 911 shape.

"We developed the next model based on this feedback and also started the development of the wheels, which are an iconic part of the design of the car.

"About a month later we visited the 911 GT3 RS design team at the Porsche Development Center in Weissach. Here we presented our model to Andreas Preuninger, Head of GT Cars, and had a good discussion on the challenges of creating a 911 and specifically his team's 911 GT3 RS in LEGO elements. We had the opportunity to demonstrate all the technical features and got feedback on the functions Mr Preuninger wished to see in the model, and in which areas he felt the car's styling could be improved.

"Then we went to the Porsche GT workshop area to see a preproduction 911 GT3 RS complete and finished in lava orange. This was the first time we saw the car in colour – all the others had been black, which Porsche uses intentionally to make it difficult to see the proportions and details of the car."

„Die Entwicklung unseres ersten Modells haben wir nur anhand von Bildern begonnen. Das Ergebnis davon haben wir dann dem Konstruktionsteam des 911 GT3 RS bei Porsche präsentiert, um die für den 911 elementaren Designmerkmale und die Karosserieform zu diskutieren.“

„Das nächste Modell haben wir auf der Grundlage dieser Rückmeldung entwickelt und parallel mit der Entwicklung der Räder begonnen, die ein wichtiger Teil des legendären Designs dieses Autos sind.“

„Etwa einen Monat später besuchten wir das Konstruktionsteam des 911 GT3 RS vor Ort im Porsche Entwicklungszentrum in Weissach. Wir präsentierten dem Gesamtprojektleiter GT-Straßenfahrzeuge Andreas Preuninger unser Modell und sprachen ausführlich über die Herausforderungen, den 911 – und speziell den 911 GT3 RS – aus LEGO Elementen zu konstruieren. Bei dieser Gelegenheit konnten wir all die technischen Eigenschaften des Modells zeigen. Mit Andreas Preuninger diskutierten wir, welche Funktionen übernommen werden sollten und wie wir elementare Designelemente des Modells verbessern konnten.“

„Beim Besuch des Porsche GT-Werkstattbereichs konnten wir einen Prototyp des 911 GT3 RS begutachten, der bereits fertiggestellt und in Lavaorange lackiert war. Das war das erste Mal, dass wir das Auto in Farbe sahen. Bis dahin haben wir es nur in Schwarz gesehen, was es viel schwieriger machte, die Proportionen und Details des Autos zu erkennen.“

“Back in Billund at LEGO Group HQ we started the development of the wing elements, as it became clear we needed a more defined outline to the wheel arch area of the car, both front and rear. This was one of our biggest challenges, as we needed to design an element to work on the 911 GT3 RS but also to be a LEGO Technic element that would work with all our other elements and be something that could work in our system for years to come.”

“On returning from Porsche, the real hard work of the project began – the graphic designer started working on the required decorations and stickers, the model designer worked further on the styling using the new elements to great effect. This was an extremely difficult stage for the development of the gearbox and the designer went through many different versions before we ended up developing one last new element to make the gearbox run smoothly.”

“The next big step was the final approval at Porsche. We got it. And after months of exciting work it was great to stand with such an accurate, function-filled model of one of the most iconic cars in the world – and to have it signed off by the designers and engineers of the real thing. A fantastic feeling all round.”

„Bei unserer Rückkehr in die Zentrale der LEGO Group in Billund begannen wir mit der Entwicklung der Kotflügel-Elemente. Es hatte sich herausgestellt, dass wir die Konturen der Radläufe vorn und hinten klarer herausarbeiten mussten. Eine der größten Herausforderungen für uns lag darin, ein Element zu kreieren, das sich sowohl für den 911 GT3 RS eignet, aber auch ganz allgemein mit allen weiteren LEGO Technic Elementen kompatibel und zudem für viele Jahre für unser System nutzbar ist.“

„Nach unserem Besuch bei Porsche stand uns die harte Arbeitsphase im Projekt bevor. A Passion for Detail

A quick look at Senior LEGO Designer Uwe Wabra's own garage clearly shows that this is someone who is into anything mechanical that can be taken apart and assembled again. Cars, motorbikes, mopeds, bicycles – pretty much everything that is mechanical and on wheels. Mix his hobbies with his 19 years of experience as a LEGO product designer, and it's easy to see why the Porsche 911 GT3 RS project landed on his desk in the LEGO Technic designer team.

"It was fantastic to get the opportunity to work on the Porsche project, but also a real challenge. As Porsche's 911 GT3 RS project was still top secret at the time, I had to build the first Technic version from 'spy-photos' from the Internet.

"I did the first prototype in a matter of weeks. We then took it to Porsche and got great feedback from the 911 GT3 RS team on both the technical details and the overall design.

Der Blick in die Garage von Senior LEGO Designer Uwe Wabra verrät sofort, dass sie jemandem gehört, der ein großer Fan von allem ist, das sich auseinandernehmen und wieder zusammensetzen lässt. Ob es nun Autos, Motorräder, Mopeds oder Fahrräder sind, es muss nur mechanisch sein und Räder haben.

In Anbetracht dieser Hobbys und seines 19-jährigen Erfahrungsschatzes als LEGO Produktdesigner ist es nur allzu verständlich, dass das Projekt für den Porsche 911 GT3 RS auf seinem Schreibtisch im LEGO Technic Designer-Team landete.

„Es war unglaublich, die Möglichkeit zu erhalten, am Porsche-Projekt zu arbeiten, aber auch eine echte Herausforderung. Das 911 GT3 RS Projekt von Porsche war zu diesem Zeitpunkt noch streng geheim, daher musste ich die erste Technic-Version mithilfe von ‚Spionagefotos‘ aus dem Internet bauen.“

- ➔ That's also when I saw the real 911 GT3 RS for the first time. I was very inspired by its minimalistic, brutal design and left Stuttgart even more eager to take our model to the next level.

"I really wanted to incorporate as many of the unique design details from the real car as possible, especially the shape of the bonnet and roof, the air-intakes and not least the low, sloping angle of the car.

"It was also important to integrate as many of the advanced technical functionalities from the real 911 GT3 RS as we could. The steering and suspension were difficult enough, but the biggest challenge was to create the functioning paddle-shift PDK gearing system.

"I am really proud of the finished model – it's great that we managed to give the LEGO Technic model the genuine 911 silhouette design-line and add so many advanced technical features." ✖

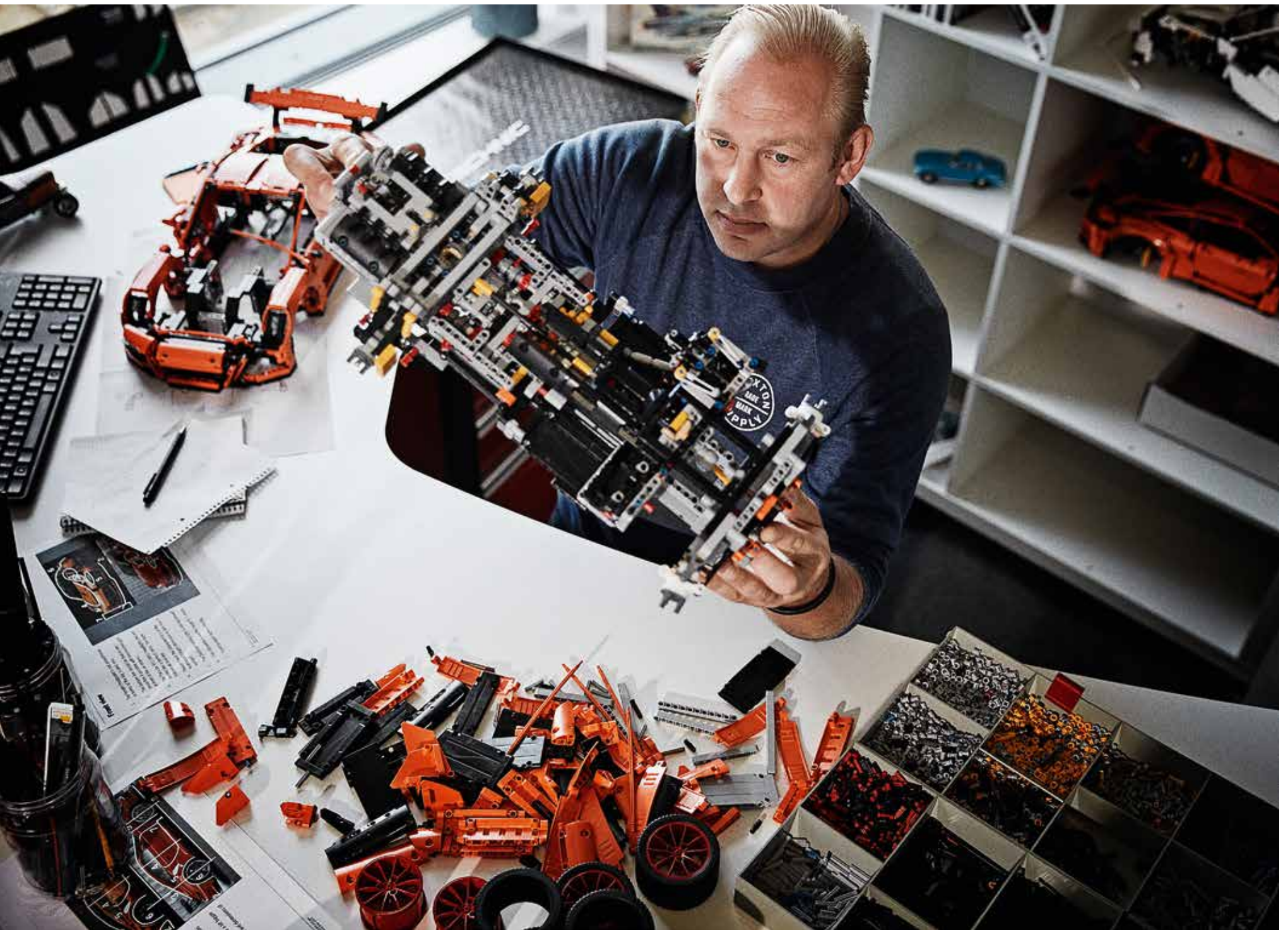

A LEGO® Memory

"This is *exactly* the one," is the immediate comment from Dr. Frank-Steffen Walliser, VP Motorsports and GT Cars at Porsche. Just returned from a victorious Porsche race weekend in the US, Dr. Walliser is pointing at an early LEGO Technic model launched in 1980 that's placed on his desk in his office.

"LEGO was a big part of my childhood. I had several LEGO models and I think I got this specific one as a Christmas present when I was about 11 years old. I still remember all its details and technical features," says Dr. Walliser, while proving his LEGO knowledge by discretely pointing out that one of the wheels on the model has been mounted the wrong way round.

"I actually made a small mistake when assembling the boxer engine. I couldn't make the pistons work properly even though I took the model apart and assembled it over and over again. My friend had the same model and his worked perfectly fine so I knew it could and should work smoothly. It nagged me for months until I got hold of the model again and finally made it work as it was supposed to.

"This LEGO Technic model was part of defining my interest in cars and later, as a teenager, helped push my education and career in the direction of technical engineering."

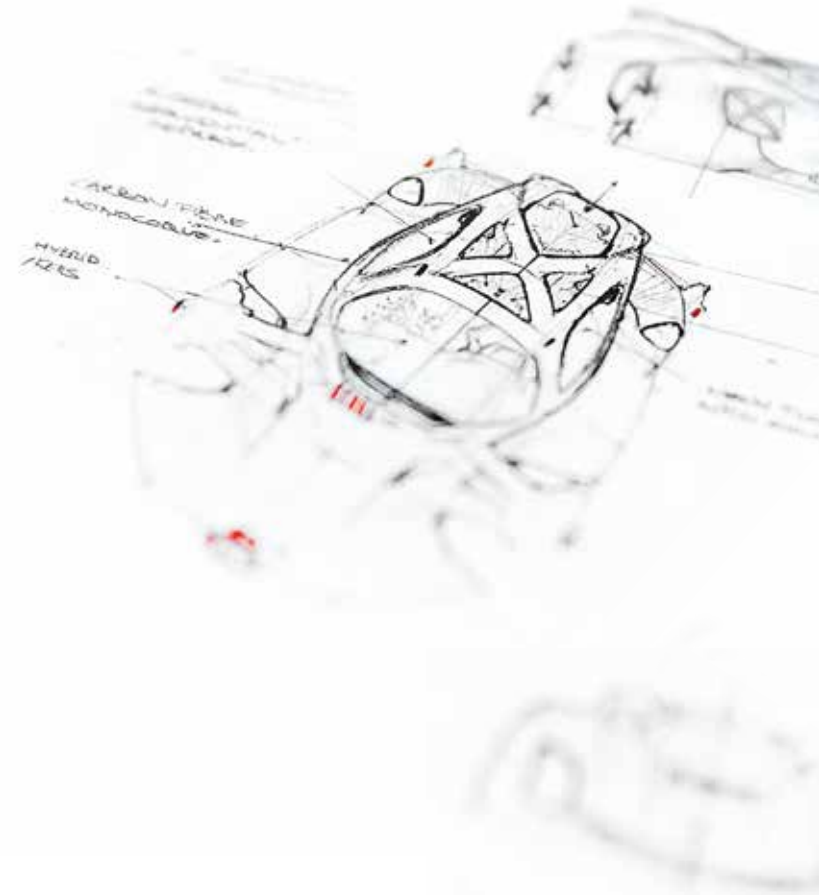
Eine LEGO® Erinnerung

„Von *genau* dem habe ich gesprochen“, so die spontane Reaktion von Dr. Frank-Steffen Walliser, Leiter Motorsport und GT-Fahrzeuge bei Porsche. „LEGO war ein wichtiger Teil meiner Kindheit. Ich besaß mehrere LEGO Modelle, und ich glaube, dieses hier habe ich zu Weihnachten bekommen, als ich ungefähr 11 Jahre alt war. Ich kann mich immer noch an alle Details und technischen Funktionen erinnern“, meint Dr. Walliser, und untermauert sein LEGO Wissen mit dem dezenten Hinweis, dass eines der Räder am Modell falsch herum montiert wurde.

„Beim Zusammenbau des Boxermotors ist mir damals ein Fehler unterlaufen. Die Kolben funktionierten nicht richtig. Und das obwohl ich das Modell immer wieder auseinandergenommen und zusammengebaut habe. Ein Freund von mir hatte das gleiche Modell, und da bei ihm alles einwandfrei funktionierte, wusste ich, dass es bei meinem auch möglich sein musste. Das hat mich monatelang beschäftigt, bis ich es endlich richtig zum Laufen gebracht habe.“

„Dieses LEGO Technic Modell hat viel zu meinem Interesse für Autos beigetragen, sodass ich mich später als Teenager für eine Ausbildung und berufliche Laufbahn in der Ingenieurtechnik entschieden habe.“ ➔



- "I am glad to see how my own kids have picked up on LEGO and LEGO Technic. My son got his first Technic set around the age of six. He is completely into it and I like the fact that it helps his understanding of how things function mechanically.

"We have a standard procedure when the kids and I begin building a new LEGO set. We sit down, closely study the box and the building instructions, and then we start sorting the bricks by colour, form and function. After that we start the actual building. For us the building of the model is play in itself.

"Looking at the LEGO Technic Porsche 911 GT3 RS model, I'm impressed that they have managed to create the distinct curved lines of the Porsche 911. I know how difficult it is to shape the softer lines with LEGO elements.

"It is great to experience the level of detail and all the working parts in the model. The functioning PDK gear is especially impressive. And I like that everything is there, even if it is eventually hidden away – just like in the real car.

"At Porsche, a car is not just a car: it's all about the design, the performance, the sense of detail and, not least, the passion and dedication. I really feel that those things are here when you look at the LEGO model." ✖

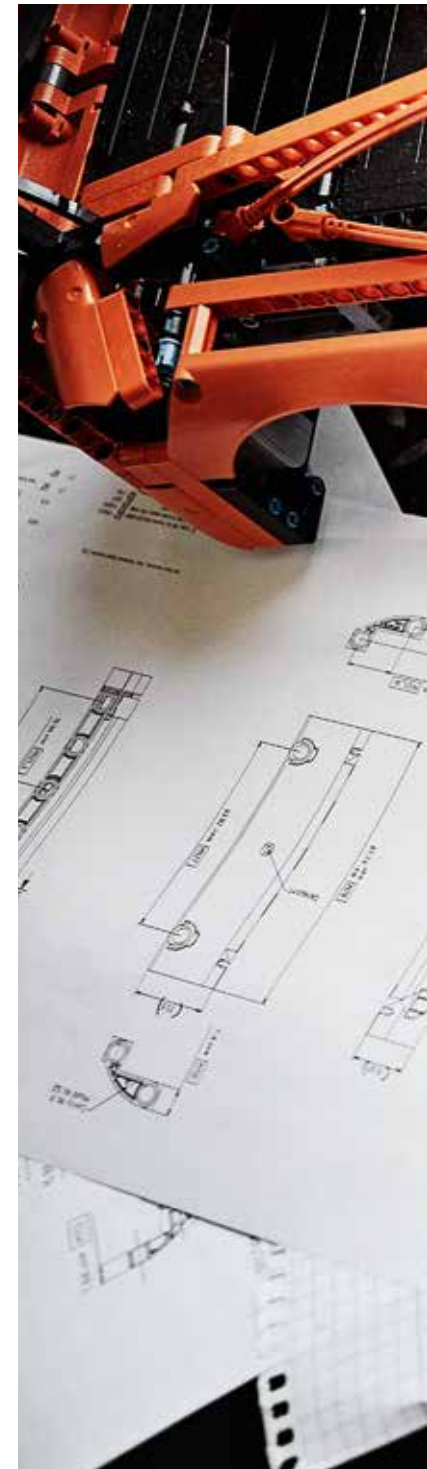

Producing Excellence

With more than 25 years of experience at Porsche, and the last three years as Plant Manager, Wolfgang Reiß is the most knowledgeable person to explain the challenges of constructing a car like the Porsche 911 GT3 RS.

"It's a special car and it takes a number of unique processes to ensure that the 2700 larger individual elements that go into the 911 GT3 RS come precisely together," says Mr Reiß. He explains that it takes four full days to assemble a Porsche 911 GT3 RS on the production line at the factory in Stuttgart and that the car will pass through the skilled hands of more than 600 specialists as it is assembled.

Produktion in höchster Qualität

Mit einer Unternehmenszugehörigkeit von 25 Jahren, die letzten drei davon als Werkleiter, ist Wolfgang Reiß ein äußerst kompetenter Ansprechpartner, um die Herausforderungen bei der Konstruktion eines Autos wie dem Porsche 911 GT3 RS zu erläutern.

„Es ist ein besonderes Auto. Und es bedarf einer Reihe spezifischer Schritte, die sicherstellen, dass die 2700 größeren Einzelkomponenten des 911 GT3 RS präzise zusammengefügt werden“, so Wolfgang Reiß. Er führt weiter aus, dass die Endmontage eines Porsche 911 GT3 RS auf der Produktionslinie des Werks in Stuttgart vier Tage sowie verschiedene Arbeitsschritte von über 600 Spezialisten in Anspruch nimmt.

Auf die Frage nach den Besonderheiten bei der Konstruktion des 911 GT3 RS nennt Wolfgang Reiß den Frontdeckel, den Heckspoiler und vor allem die ➔

Asked to describe the specific issues they have with the 911 GT3 RS construction process, Mr Reiß highlights the luggage compartment lid, spoiler and especially the fenders as unique for this model, and the rollover bar as an option.

"Normally the complete body of the car is assembled with fenders for spraying. With the 911 GT3 RS the special fenders, with their integrated outlets, are not fitted to the body during the paint shop. This gives us a special challenge later when trying to ensure a uniform gap between the door and fender.

"The so-called 'marriage' is the magic moment in the Porsche production process. It's where the heart of the car – the engine – is mounted to rest on the drivetrain and the body is lowered for final assembly. It's a piece of logistic excellence to have these central components meet and merge at one spot on the assembly line within a matter of seconds."

Asked for his reaction on seeing the LEGO Technic version of the 911 GT3 RS for the first time, Mr Reiß states, "It's clear our two companies share the same dedication to detail. It's exciting to see how far LEGO has developed since my brother and I built simple cars with LEGO when we were young boys over 40 years ago." 🚗

„Normalerweise wird die Karosserie komplett mit montierten Kotflügeln zur Lackierung vorbereitet. Der 911 GT3 RS hat aber spezielle Kotflügel mit integrierten Luftauslässen, die nicht während der Lackierung an die Karosserie montiert werden. Die besondere Herausforderung ist dabei, für ein gleichmäßiges Spaltmaß zwischen Tür und Kotflügel zu sorgen.“

„Der magische Moment im Produktionsprozess ist die sogenannte ‚Hochzeit‘, wenn das Herz des Fahrzeugs – der Motor – mit der Karosserie verbunden wird. Es ist eine logistische Meisterleistung, diese grundlegenden Komponenten innerhalb weniger Sekunden an einem Punkt der Montagelinie aufeinandertreffen zu lassen und zusammenzuführen.“

Auf seine Reaktion beim ersten Anblick der LEGO Technic Version des 911 GT3 RS angesprochen, sagt Wolfgang Reiß: „Ganz eindeutig teilen unsere beiden Firmen dieselbe Liebe zum Detail. Es ist spannend zu sehen, wie sich LEGO weiterentwickelt hat, seit mein Bruder und ich als Kinder vor mehr als 40 Jahren einfache Autos mit LEGO gebaut haben.“ 🚗
